COMPETITION REGULATIONS

1. Introduction
- 1.1. Latvian drag racing competition are organized in accordance with the Latvian Automobile Federation (hereinafter - LAF) National Sports Code, the regulatory documents of the LAF Drift Commission, the Latvian Drag Race Cup 2026 regulations, including their annexes, as well as the Regulations of this Drag Race event. Amendments and additions to these Regulations shall be announced only through dated supplements to the Regulations, approved by the Organizer or the Commissioner.
- 1.2. The 2nd stage of the Lithuanian Championship is organized based on the LASF regulatory documents, which are available for review: <https://www.lasf.lt/lt/dragas/reg/>.
- 1.3. The Baltic Cup qualifying round is organized based on the rules of the Baltic Cup Commission, which are available for review: <https://balticdragracing.eu/rules/>.
- 1.4. Sports cars must comply with the technical regulations of the respective class, the regulations of the Latvian Drag Racing Cup 2026 and the technical regulations of the Latvian Drag Racing Cup 2026 - <https://laf.lv/sports/drifta-un-dragreisa-komisijs/dragreiss/nolikumi/>.
- 1.5. All riders, entrants, organizers and officials, each in their own name, as well as their subordinate employees, who are involved in the competition, comply with and shall adhere to

the LAF National Sports Code (hereinafter – the Code), these Regulations (hereinafter – the Regulations) and the documents subordinate to them.

- 1.6. For information on the Baltic Cup moto stage, please refer to Bulletin No. 1 of the regulations.
- 1.7. The Regulations are published in Latvian. In cases of disputes arising from translations and interpretations by the editorial staff, the decisive language is Latvian.
2. All the persons who are in any form within the territory of a motorsports event or participating in a competition:
 - 2.1. Do so at their own risk and are fully aware that motorsport is dangerous and involves significant risks that may result in injuries, health damage, disability, and death, as well as damage to property and belongings or other losses.
 - 2.2. They acknowledge that the LAF, the organizer, and the competition officials are not liable for injuries or damage that occur during the competition (or any other motorsport event).
3. Competition dates: July 31 – 2 August, 2026.
4. Competition venue: Latvia, Ventspils Airport territory.
5. Distance: quarter mile (402.336 meters).
6. Festival competition format: according to the “2026 LATVIAN DRAG RACE CUP REGULATIONS” POINT 9.2.8. (<https://www.fia.com/regulation/category/101>).
7. Schedule of the day: as per Annex No. 1.

13. Competition Participants
 - 13.1. Any natural person who has a car that meets the technical requirements of the Regulations and holds either an annual or one-event drag racing license issued by the LAF Drift Commission, or a valid drag racing license issued by any other country ASN recognized

- by the FIA. The Participant must also hold a valid life insurance policy, approved by the LAF, with coverage of no less than EUR 1500.00.
- 13.2. Licenses and insurance can be purchased at www.laflcences.lv or on site on the day of the event.
- 13.3. The annual license fee is EUR 50.00 (when applying for an annual license, a medical certificate confirming the applicant's general health condition must be submitted). Licenses can be obtained at www.laflcences.lv.
- 13.4. The single license fee is EUR 30.00 (when applying for a single license, the applicant must submit either a medical declaration (available in the user profile at www.laflcences.lv) or a medical certificate (U27).

14. Membership fees
- Participation fee must be paid online by 28 July 2026, (it will also be possible to pay on site on the day of the event. Fees will not change on the day of the event):
- 14.1. **EUR 100.00** - Latvian Drag Race Festival Participants (price includes participation +1 mechanic pass),
- 14.2. **EUR 60.00** – Participation in an additional class for Latvian Drag Race Festival Participants,
- 14.3. **EUR 25.00** – Additional mechanic pass,
- 14.4. **EUR 10.00** – Additional service vehicle (one service vehicle with or without trailer included for each rider),
- 14.5. **EUR 100.00** - Lithuanian Championship Participants (price includes participation +1 mechanic pass),
- 14.6. **EUR 60.00** - Participation in an additional class for Lithuanian Championship Participants,
- 14.7. **EUR 150.00-200.00** - Baltic Cup Participants (payment for Baltic Cup participants is made on site on the day of the event),
- 14.8. **EUR 25.00** - Additional mechanic's pass.
- 14.9. **EUR 10.00** - Additional service vehicle (one service vehicle with or without trailer included for each rider).
- 14.10. At the Latvian Drag Racing Festival, cars are divided into the following classes:

DAILY DRIVE	The DAILY class includes vehicles that possess a valid and current national technical inspection certificate and do not complete 402 meters faster than 15.5 seconds or 201 meters faster than 10 seconds. Vehicles must comply with the 2026 Latvian Drag Racing Cup technical regulations for the STOCK category.
STREET LEGAL	The STREET LEGAL class includes vehicles that possess a valid and current national technical inspection certificate and do not complete 402 meters faster than 14.5 seconds or 201 meters faster than 9.3 seconds. Vehicles must comply with the 2026 Latvian Drag Racing Cup technical regulations for the STOCK class.

STREET AXE	The STREET AX class is designated for vehicles that do not complete 402 meters faster than 13.5 seconds or 201 meters faster than 8.5 seconds. Vehicles must comply with the 2026 Latvian Drag Racing Cup technical regulations for the STREET A class.
SUPER STOCK	The SUPER STOCK class is designated for vehicles that do not complete 402 meters faster than 12.5 seconds or 201 meters faster than 7.9 seconds. Vehicles must comply with the 2026 Latvian Drag Racing Cup technical regulations for the STREET B class.
SUPER STREET AX	The SUPER STREET AX class is designated for vehicles that do not complete 402 meters faster than 11.5 seconds or 201 meters faster than 7.3 seconds.
SUPER STREET A	SUPER STREET A class for passenger cars, without engine and drivetrain restrictions Index: 10.90 seconds over 402 meters or 6.90 seconds over 201 meters. The equipment required for this class is related to the Outlaw class regulations. For additional requirements, see Section 11 of this Regulation. *Additional provisions in Appendix No. 2.
SUPER GAS	The Super GAS (SG) class is for passenger vehicles with no engine restrictions. Index: 9.999 seconds over 402 meters or 6.3 seconds over 201 meters. See the annual technical regulations of the Latvian Drag Racing Cup: 'ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR VEHICLES WITH RUN TIMES OF 10.999 (6.99) SECONDS OR FASTER.' The driver's safety equipment must comply with FIA Standard 8856-2000 or 8856-2018, including racing suit, balaclava, underwear, socks, shoes, and gloves."
OUTLAW	The OUTLAW class is for 'tube frame' vehicles and lightweight sports cars with no engine restrictions. Index: 7.50 seconds over 402 meters or 4.50 seconds over 201 meters.

14.11. **The participation fee includes: 2 mechanic's pass, a race car pass, one technical vehicle or trailer. No additional passes will be provided for participation in an additional class.**

15. Responsibility of participants

- 15.1. Each Participant and the vehicle owner are responsible for the technical condition of the vehicle and for all actions taken during the competition, as well as the consequences thereof.
- 15.2. By completing and signing the Participant Card, the Participant confirms that they have read and undertake to comply with the present Competition Regulations, technical requirements, and the instructions of the responsible officials and their subordinates. The Participant also acknowledges responsibility for their technical and service crew, as well as any accompanying persons. The Participant bears responsibility for the technical condition of the vehicle and undertakes to observe order, cleanliness, and generally accepted standards of ethics.
- 15.3. All Participants must use a service mat in the Participant area of the competition venue and park their vehicle on a mat no smaller than 6x3 meters (six by three meters), or on a mat that extends at least 50 cm beyond the outer edges of the vehicle. Failure to comply with this rule will result in a fine of EUR 50.00. Additionally, each pit area must be equipped with a fire extinguisher – minimum capacity of 4 kg, marked with ABC classification, powder type. If a fire extinguisher is not present, a fine of EUR 50.00 will be applied.
- 15.4. Open flames and the use of grills by Participants within the competition area are strictly prohibited. Violation of this rule will result in a fine of EUR 100.00.
- 15.5. Overnight stays in the competition area are prohibited.
- 15.6. It is strictly prohibited to cause any mechanical damage within the event area (e.g., anchoring canopies, tents, etc.). The use of lifting equipment with wheels that may indent or damage the asphalt surface is not allowed. Violation of this rule will result in a fine of EUR 1,000.00.
- 15.7. 'Burnouts' or tire warming is permitted only in the designated area. Performing tire warming outside the designated zone will result in a fine of EUR 500.00.
16. Starting Procedure
 - 16.1. The number of Participants in each class is unlimited. The competition organizer and the chief judge may decide on the day of the competition to limit, reduce or increase the number of Participants, as well as to combine classes if there are fewer than 3 Participants in any of them.
 - 16.2. The starting position is electronically controlled based on the front axle wheels of the vehicle.
 - 16.3. The Participant must arrive at the starting area within five (5) minutes after being called by the start line official. If the Participant does not arrive within five (5) minutes after the call, they will be considered to have lost the run. The call may be made to the Participant personally or via microphone through the competition's PA system.
 - 16.4. During the distance, the Participant is allowed to drive only on the selected track. The Participant with the better qualifying result has priority in choosing the track in the pair and is listed first in the start order.
 - 16.5. After crossing the finish line, the driver must gradually reduce speed in a straight line. Before performing any turning maneuvers, it is mandatory to ensure that no hazardous situation will be created.
17. Competition safety regulations
 - 17.1. The event organizers ensure the security of the racetrack.
 - 17.2. The event organizers have the right to require the Participant to undergo a medical examination for alcohol or other intoxicants during the event. Additionally, they may require further inspection by the Technical Commission for safety reasons concerning the competition vehicle.

- 17.3. Competition Participants and spectators are prohibited from attempting to enter restricted areas without authorization.
- 17.4. The speed limit in the racetrack area is 30 km/h, except for the section of the track designated for the race from start to finish. After crossing the finish line, the speed must be gradually reduced to the permitted limit. In the case of speeding or aggressive driving, the Participant will be disqualified from the race.
- 17.5. During the race, Participants must wear seat belts, and convertible roofs must be in place.
- 17.6. Smoking is only allowed in designated areas within the event premises. A fine of EUR 50.00 will be imposed on the Participant for non-compliance, while others may be expelled from the event premises.
- 17.7. During the race, the Participant must wear a helmet. The helmet must be of an appropriate size for the Participant, with the fastening strap properly secured during the race. The helmet must not be damaged, with signs of accidents or cracks. In the Daily, Street Legal, Street AX, Super Stock, and Super Street AX classes, helmets with a minimum 'E' marking, and helmets with valid or expired FIA/SFI homologation are strongly recommended.
- 17.8. In the Outlaw, Super Gas, and Super Street A classes, helmets with valid FIA/SFI homologation are MANDATORY.
- 18. Advertising
 - 18.1. The event organizer's advertising placement on Participants' vehicles is mandatory – failure to display the advertising will result in a 100% participation fee charge.
 - 18.2. Advertising stickers must be placed in accordance with the placement plan issued by the organizer.
- 19. Results and awarding
 - 19.1. At the Latvian Drag Racing Festival 2026, the top three drivers in each class will be awarded.
 - 19.2. The awarding ceremony takes place in the track area, at the starting zone, following the confirmation of the Chief Judge.
 - 19.3. In case of Force Majeure, if only qualifying runs have taken place and at least one qualifying run was completed for all registered Participants in the competition stage, results will be determined based on the qualifying results.
 - 19.4. If the event is cancelled not due to the organizer's fault, the registration fee will be refunded 85%. If the event is cancelled due to unfavorable weather conditions (rain, snow, storm, or other natural factors), the registration fee will be refunded 50%. If qualifying runs have taken place, the winners will be determined based on the qualifying times and the participation fee will not be refunded.

1. Additional requirements for Super street A 10.9 class

THE REGULATIONS INCLUDE EXEMPTIONS FOR CARS MANUFACTURED FROM 2010 AND EQUIPPED WITH INDUSTRIALLY DEVELOPED SAFETY REQUIREMENTS, OR IF THE MANUFACTURER HAS DESIGNATED SUCH A TIME FOR THE SPECIFIC TRACK DISTANCE.

- 1.1. Super street A cars must comply with the Latvian Drag Racing Cup 2026 technical regulations (<https://laf.lv/sports/drifta-un-dragreisa-komisija/dragreiss/tehniskie-noteikumi/>) Regulations, Section No. 11 “ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR VEHICLES WITH A DISTANCE TIME OF 10.999 (6.99) * SECONDS OR FASTER”.
- 1.2. Within the framework of this competition, an exception is also made for cars that are equipped with a safety hoop and fully comply with the requirements of **Section No. 11** of the Drag Race Cup 2026 Technical Regulations “ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR VEHICLES WITH A DISTANCE TIME OF 11.499 (7.3)* SECONDS OR FASTER”. An exception is also made for cars that were manufactured from 01.01.2015 and for which **the manufacturer has provided a time of 10.9 seconds for a distance of 402.336 meters**. Information about car times can be viewed (<https://www.0-60specs.com/0-60-times/>).
- 1.3. The final decision on the car's admission to the competition is made by the chief judge.
- 1.4. Factory-made vehicles with a factory-installed safety hoop (safety frame), manufactured after January 1, 2010, may start with a time limit of up to 10 seconds. These vehicles must not be rebuilt or modified in any way and must fully correspond to the original factory version.
- 1.5. Participants in the Super Street A class shall strictly comply with the Drag Racing Cup 2026 Technical Regulations, including **Section 1**, “General Requirements for Drivers,” and **Section 2**, “General Requirements for Vehicles.” Furthermore, full compliance with **Clause 1.2 of Section 1** of the Technical Regulations is mandatory, which stipulates that in the Outlaw and Super Street A classes, the use of motorsport helmets with a valid and current FIA or SFI homologation is **OBLIGATORY. The Latvian Drag Racing Festival 2026 will host the 2 stage of the Lithuanian Championship and the qualifying round of the Baltic Cup.

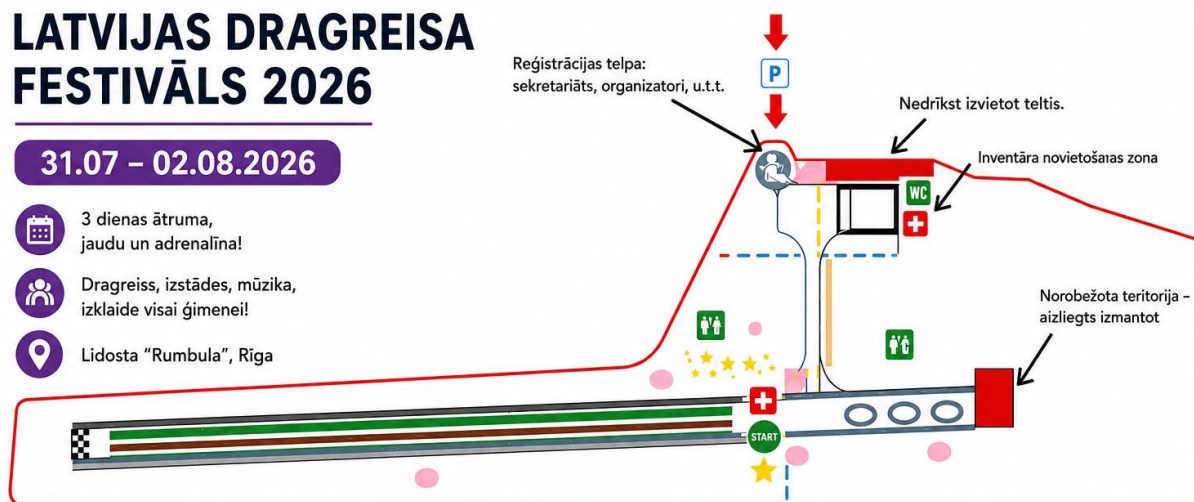
