SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

2nd August, 2025

1. ORGANIZATION OF COMPETITION

1.1. The Competition shall be organized in accordance with these specific supplementary regulations of the racing event – “RING CHALLENGE - II EVENT” (2025RC2) and in compliance and reference to the Sporting and Technical Regulations of the respective racing series as follows:

BaTA – in accordance with BaTA Sporting Regulations 2025 Above regulations published on the official Ring Challenge communication channel / notice board on the Sportity App (password: 2025RC2) or www.balticracingseries.eu and/or www.ringchallenge.lt

1.2. The Competition shall be held on the “Nemuno žiedas” racetrack (<https://www.lscentras.lt/lt/sporto-bazes/nemuno-ziedas>) 02.08.2025

1.3. The Competition is the event for the following racing classes:

2. DATA OF COMPETITION

2.1. General data:

Track length: 3301 meters (one lap)

Driving direction: counterclockwise

Track surface: asphalt

Number of competitors on the grid: limited to max 25

Number of participants in BaTA competition: limited to max 75 in case of 3 race sessions (default set up) o limited to max 100 in case of 4 race sessions (secondary set up)

2.2. Race format, duration of races, starting procedure, determination of the starting grid, qualifying format, technical scrutineering and determination of the winners as well as the points scoring table are organized in accordance with the actual Sporting Regulations of the respective racing series and in accordance with the event program. Detailed Timetable of the Competition will be announced with the separate Bulletin latest by 26.07.2025.

3. REGISTERING FOR COMPETITION

3.1. Upon pre-registration, the participation applications shall be submitted via the website choosing the competition from the list that the person wishes to register for. (Link: www.ringchallenge.lt/registration/)

3.2. Pre-registration shall be opened as from 14 st July and it shall be closed on 1st of August 2025 at 20:00 local time. Late registration is possible during the Competition in accordance with the timetable.

3.3. Participants driving in BALTIC STREET (BS2, BS3, BS4) and BALTIC SEMI PRO (BSP3 and BSP4) must have their national C, B or A driver licence or one time C category licence which is issued on the racing day. Only participants with A category driver licences of their country can participate in BALTIC PRO (BP2 and BPOpen) classes.

3.4. A Competitor has pre-registered if, by the term provided in clause 3.2., they have complied with the following conditions:

- a) The Competitor has submitted the registration application specified in clause 3.1.;
- b) The entry charges for the competition have been paid either to the bank account specified in clause 4.3., or in cash at the secretariat of the Competition. The burden of proof with regards to proving compliance with the term of paying the entry charges lies with the Competitor. Any and all expenses related to paying the entry charges shall be borne by the Competitor. Charges are stated below:

3.5. Following the closing of the pre-registration, registering for the competitions shall be possible at the secretariat of the Competition pursuant to timetable of the Competition.

3.6. By submitting a participation application, the Competitor represents and warrants that:

- it undertakes to comply with the rules and regulations of the Competition;
- the competing vehicle corresponds to the technical conditions and requirements of the respective class;
- the Competitor shall be liable for the loss of or damage to the timing transponder;
- the Competitor understands that participating in motorsports competitions poses a hazard for their life and health as well as the equipment to be used but nevertheless agrees to participate in the competitions at their own liability. The Organizer, the team members of the Organizer, the track owner and the team members of the track owner shall not be liable for any possible accidents and the consequences thereof. The Competitor shall discharge the aforesaid people from any liability;
- the Competitor is in good health, in accordance with the conclusion of the doctor, is allowed to do racing but in spite of that undertakes to have an appropriate and valid health insurance policy which might be necessary in case of accident during Competition;

4. ENTRY FEES

4.1. In order to be permitted to participate in the Competition, Competitor must pay a participation Entry Fee in favor of the Organizer of the Competition.

4.2. Entry Fees for the Competition are in accordance with BaTA Sporting Regulations 2025

4.4. The Organizer has the right to invite special VIP Competitors and participants free of charge.

4.5. If a Competitor is excluded from the Competition by a decision of the Race Directors, the paid entry charges shall not be refunded.

4.6. If a pre-registered Competitor notifies the Organizer of non-participation in the Competition before the end of the pre-registration term in a format that can be reproduced in writing, 50% of the paid entry charges will be refunded.

5. ADVERTISING AND AUDIO-VISUAL MATERIALS

5.1. The Layout of the compulsory advertising stickers on the racing cars (if any) will be published as the Bulletin not later than 01.08.2025, otherwise, conditions of the actual Sporting Regulations of the respective racing series and classes to apply.

6. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

6.1. For the BaTA racing series, the process of submitting a protest and/or appeal as well as the handling the same are processed in accordance with the conditions in paragraph #9 of the sporting regulations.

7. AWARD CEREMONY

7.1. The award ceremony shall take place in accordance with the official timetable of the Competition based on the preliminary results.

7.2. The award ceremony is compulsory for the winners of each class to participate in the ceremony.

7.3. Wearing the racing suit during the award ceremony shall be mandatory. Upon not wearing the racing suit or being absent from the award ceremony, a fine of EUR 100,- shall be imposed on the Competitor.

7.4. The number of winners obliged to participate in the award ceremony and agenda of the ceremony will be announced during the drivers briefing.

8. PASSES

8.1. All people present in the territory of the track of the Competition must carry valid passes issued by the Organizer.

8.2. Parking passes entitles to park a vehicle in the parking lot indicated therein. Filled in parking pass must be affixed to the windshield. Each team may have max 2 service vehicles in the Paddock.

8.3. Damaged passes can be exchanged in the Secretariat of the Competition.

8.4. When registering for the Competition, Competitors of all other racing series will receive the following number of passes: Drivers – 1 pass (for access to the Paddock); Mechanics – 3 passes (for access to the Paddock); Service vehicles – 1 pass (for access to the Paddock).

8.5. Upon request of the Competitor additional passes for access to the Paddock can be purchased. The price of one pass is EUR 10,-. Each competitor is allowed to purchase limited number of passes, providing maximum 10 passes per Competitor in total.
